RELEASE FROM LIABILITY FORM

This RELEASE FROM LIABILITY is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 2009, by and between Liz Koscielniak and _____, Hereinafter designated RIDER; and Rider is a minor, Rider's parent or guardian, _____. In return for the use today and on all future days, of property, facilities, and service of the Owner/Manager/Instructor, the Rider, his heirs, assigns and legal representatives, hereby expressly agree to the following:

1. Rider is responsible for full and complete insurance coverage on his horse, personal property, and himself.
2. Rider understands there are risks in and around equine activities, and that an equine activity sponsor and/or equine professional and/or Owner/Manager/Instructor is not liable for an injury to, or death of, a rider, and/or participant in equine activities.
3. RIDER AGREES TO ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FROM RIDERS USE OF PRESENCE UPON OWNER/MANAGER/INSTRUCTOR'S PROPERTY AND FACILITIES including without limitations but not limited to: risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, fire or explosion, the unavailability of emergency medical care, and/or the negligence and/or deliberate act of another person.
4. Rider agrees to hold Owner/Manager/Instructor and all successors, assigns, subsidiaries, franchisees, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, and agents completely harmless and not liable and releases them from all liability whatsoever and AGREES NOT TO SUE THEM on account of or connection with any claims, cause of action, injuries, damages, cost or expense arising out of rider's use of or presence upon Owner/Manager's/Instructor's property and facilities, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages, except if the damages are caused by the direct, willful and wanton gross negligence of the Owner/Manager/Instructor.
5. Rider agrees to waive the protection afforded by any statute or law in any jurisdiction whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend claims, material, or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing the release.
6. Rider agrees to indemnify and defend Owner/Manager/Instructor against, and hold harmless from any and all claims, causes of action, damages, judgments, costs or expenses, including attorney fees, which in anyway arises from rider's use of or presence upon the Owner's/Manager's/Instructor's property and facilities.
7. Rider agrees to abide by all of Owner's/Manager's/Instructor's rules and regulations, and rider is responsible for using protective gear; i.e. hard hats and boots.
8. If Rider is using Rider's horse, the horse shall be free from infection, contagious or transmittable diseases. Owner/Manager/Instructor reserves the right to refuse any horse if not in proper health or deemed dangerous or undesirable.
9. This contract is non-assignable and non-transferable and is made and entered into the State of Michigan and shall be enforced and interpreted under the laws of this state. Should any clause be in conflict with state Law, then that clause is null and void. When the Owner/Manager/Instructor and Rider (Riders Guardian, if rider is a minor) sign this contract, it will then be binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and contracts.
